


Historical reference. Stanyuta Stephaniya Mikhailovna (13.05.1905 - 06.11.2000) is an outstanding actress, the legend of the Belarus stage and motion pictures. She had the honorary title of the People's Actress of the former BSSR (1957) and USSR (1988). She was the State prize laureate of the BSSR (1982) and also got different prizes at film festivals. Stephaniya Stanyuta began her actress career in 1918 and worked as a supernumerary, a chorister, and a dancer. In 1926 she graduated from the Drama Studio attached to the Moscow Academic Art Theatre. In 1926—32 she was an actress of the 2nd Belarusian Drama Theatre in Vitebsk. From 1932 and till the end of her life Stanyuta worked in Minsk as an actress of the National Academic Theatre named after Yanka Kupala. She went on stage until the end of life at 95 years of age. Stanyuta was equally persuasive playing an exhausted peasant woman or an elegant woman of a high society. She had many interesting roles in theatre and cinema but real fame came to her at late age when she played parts of elderly women and grandmothers. Stanyuta became popular outside Belarus after the film "Farewell" directed by Elem Klimov (1982) where she played the role of the old woman Dariya. Stanyuta acted in films a lot in the last years of her life too. She had the most remarkable roles in "Eti... tri vernye karty..." (1988), "Exiled" (1991) and "A Silhouette in the Window across the Street" (1993).
