Historical reference. Mikhail Sevruk (27.02.1905, Warsaw — 14.03.1979) is a Belarussian painter and drawer. He graduated from the art faculty of the Vilnya University. Since 1939 he lived in Nesvizh town in Belarus. His early works are characterized by romanticism. His later works are notable for folk images, sculptural forms, thorough drawing. Among his art works are such thematic compositions as "Beetroot harvesting" (1936), "Harvesting" (1937), "New house" (1968), etc. M. Sevruk was a designer of the covers of poetry books of M. Tank "At stages of life" (1936) and the book of songs by G. Shirma "Our song" (1938). He is the author of the drawings "Vilnya Alma mater', etc. In 1994 in Nesvizh in the apartment where M. Sevruk lived a museum was created.
