**Designers:** Maria Plakhotnyuk & Ivan Lukin. **Printing:** offset. **Colour:** multicoloured. **Paper:** chalk-surfaced, gummed. **Perforation:** comb 14:14<sup>1/4</sup>. **Size** of the stamp: 40x28 mm. **Sheet composition:** 9 (3x3) stamps. **Size of the sheet:** 136x102 mm. **Print quantity:** 45.000 stamps.
