Beginning Nos. 889, 920, 921, 980, 1040 and 1050. **Design:** Yelena Medved. **Printing:** offset. **Colour:** full colour. **Paper:** chalk-surfaced, gummed. **Perforation:** comb 13^{1/2}:13. **Size of the stamp:** 37x26 mm. **Sheet composition:** 6 (2x3) stamps. **Size of the sheet:** 100x97 mm. **Print quantity:** 60.000 stamps.

The stamp was printed at the Republican Unitary Enterprise "Bobruisk Integrated Printing House named after A.T.Nepogodin".



In 2011 Communications Administrations - members of RCC signed the Agreement on issuing postage stamps of RCC subjects. The first issue of RCC subjects was the stamp "20th anniversary of RCC" (2011), the second - 2 stamps of the series "Belarusian national clothes" (2012), the third was the stamp "History of national communications" (2013) the fourth stamp was "Winter sports. Biathlon" (2014) and the fifth stamp was "Architectural monuments of capitals. Church of Saints Simon and Helena" (2015).

In 2014 a new Addition to the Agreement for the period from 2016 to 2020 was signed. The first issue of this period is the stamp "National cuisine. Kalduny".

The RCC stamp issues are notable for using the emblem of RCC in their design.
